Sydney - Tuesday - October 21: (RWE Aust Business News) - **Island Sky** Australia (ASX:ISK) reports an additional \$2 million payment as part of its agreement with American Corporation Salton.

The company, which manufactures and distributes unique "air to water" making machines, signed an exclusive \$5 million licensing distribution agreement with the American corporation, Salton Inc, earlier this year.
